## LOCAL, ENVIRONMENTAL AND EFFICIENT PURCHASING POLICY

Ejder Ski Centers Inc. recognizes the following items as a guide to its structure with the motto "A more sustainable world, a more sustainable Palandöken" during the operation and execution of Palandöken Destination.

•	All kinds of consumables, food, beverages, construction, maintenance and repair materials, etc. to be purchased for hotels and destinations must be of a quality that will not harm the environment.
•	<i>Products included in certification programs on environmental sensitivity should be preferred.</i>
•	In the purchase of wood, paper, fish, other foods, and products that may come from the wild, the feature of being absolutely sustainable and not harming the nature should be sought.
•	In the event that the certified product cannot be supplied in the region and domestically, the origin and method must be taken into account during the growth or production phase.
•	No material directly or indirectly related to threatened species should be used or sold.
•	Care should be taken to make purchases that will minimize waste, and the purchase of consumables, including food, and disposable goods should be carefully managed.
•	<i>Reusable, returnable, recycled or recyclable goods should be preferred for purchases.</i>
•	The purchase and use of consumables and disposable goods must be specifically monitored and managed.
•	Unnecessary packaging, especially plastic, should be avoided, regardless of whether bulk or individual.
•	First of all, all purchases will be preferred from local suppliers and manufacturers.
