STATISTICS**

All data with statistical use is digitized and archived.



KEY FINDINGS

Qualified results from SDG projects and activities are reported and archived.



REPORT CARDS

Fixed evaluation matrices are used for transparent reporting.



INFORMATION GRAPHS

The data is processed and archived with graphics in a visual-based and understandable format as much as possible.



TIMELINES

Activity follow-ups are made, reported and archived on a regular basis with the instructions taken from fixed tables.

The common locations of plant and animal species known to exist in the Palandöken Destination were largely determined in the observation studies carried out with the motto "We are stepping every square meter" in the summer months of 2021 and 2022.

- Multiple research centers should be provided in the region in the format of winter technologies institute.

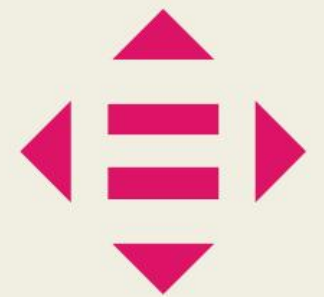
